## CQ Project Journal Construction Steps

- 1. Put your full name, my name (Mr. Byrne), and your period number in ink on both the front inside cover of journal and the back inside cover
- 2. Page 1 is the Book Plate page for the Journal.
  - This is where you will put "This Journal Belongs To:.... You will then decoratively place your name and any other personalization you care to have.
- 3. Page 3 is the Cover Page for the entire project.
  - Leave this blank except for a penciled-in "Project Cover Page." You will complete this later when you have been with your project for a while and have a feeling about it.
- 4. Page 5 is the Cover Page for the <u>Preparation Materials</u> section
  - Pencil in the label first, then you can label and personalize this section after you put in all your preparation materials.
- 5. <u>Working Bibliography</u> (cover page) begins on <u>the first right hand page</u> after the Preparation Materials section. Leave 6-8 pages for the Working Bibliography.
  - Pencil in the label first, then you can label and personalize this page at any time.
- 6. <u>Data Collection section</u> (cover page) begins on <u>the first right hand page</u> after the last reserved page of the Working Bibliography.
  - Pencil in the label first, then you can label and personalize this page at any time.
- 7. The <u>Exploration Phase</u> cover page begins on <u>the first right hand page</u> after the Data Collection section cover page.
  - Pencil in the label first, then you can label and personalize <u>this when</u> <u>you have finished the Exploration Phase</u>. You should show your experience with your exploration at that time in your personalization.
  - You are now ready to enter data.

## **Order of Items in Preparation Materials**

With each of the items on the list, begin them on a right hand side page until you complete entry, then begin the next item on a right hand side page

- 1. Notebook Organization Instructions (2 pages) *Exception*! Paste on first left side page and the companion right side page.
- 2. Your 100 Questions-right side page
- 3. Top 20 Questions-right side page
- 4. Top 10 Questions– right side page
  - With Themes
- 5. Essential Question Rubric-right side page
- 6. Personal Interest / Complexity Rubric- right side page
- 7. Top 5 Questions and Grid-right side page
- 8. Your Essential Question on the first right hand side page after top 5 question grid.
- 9. Leave 2-3 Blank Pages
- 10.Begin Working Bibliography Cover Page on first right hand side page

## Extra Note:

Your CQ Project Overview Manual should go in a pocket in your journal. If journal does not have a pocket, make one on the inside front or back cover.
