# **Auditory Literacy**

- 1 Music CD: (CD must demonstrate by its play list, connections to your topic, or you must supply a written annotation of how you see the different pieces applying to your topic.
- 1 (Tape or CD) of a lecture, seminar, self-improvement, etc. related to your topic.

#### Field Experience

- 1 Interview with a person who is working in the field you are studying. It could be a business, academic, medical, legal, trades, etc, person)
- 1 Trip to a location or tour of an area that can apply to your topic. Some examples might be:
