

Minimal Reading Requirements for CQ to be Met by June 1, 2005

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Printed References: Text Literacy

- 6 Books: Cover to Cover
 - Text Book
 - Subject Book
 - Novel
 - Biography / Autobiography
 - Play (Drama)
 - Other Choices
- 6 parts of other books: Chapters, Pages, Paragraphs, or Sentences
- 3 Magazine and / or Newspaper Articles
- 4 Journal Articles

Visual References: Visual Literacy

- 1 Movie (Film, Video, or DVD)
- 2 Educational Channel Programs, or 1 Series
- 1 Documentary (Film, Video, or DVD)
- 1 Educational Video / DVD / CD-ROM

Internet References: Web Literacy

- 6 Articles, all from different web sites
 - They can be Written Articles, Power Point presentations on a web site; or data in some other form presented on a web site.

Auditory Literacy

- 1 Music CD: (CD must demonstrate by its play list, connections to your topic, or you must supply a written annotation of how you see the different pieces applying to your topic.
- 1 (Tape or CD) of a lecture, seminar, self-improvement, etc. related to your topic.

Field Experience

- 1 Interview with a person who is working in the field you are studying. It could be a business, academic, medical, legal, trades, etc. person)
- 1 Trip to a location or tour of an area that can apply to your topic. Some examples might be:
 - a museum, church, research institution (university department or school)
 - seminary
 - performing arts school (public, private, or an owned business)
 - Fermilab,
 - company involved in the production of goods, services, or information
 - library (college, or specialized like the Newberry Library downtown, etc.
 - Run your ideas by me or ask me for ideas if you are stumped.)
 - Attendance at a live lecture, seminar, workshop, educational tour, etc.
