## Curiosity Quest Editorial/Dialogue/Invention Journal Entry

On the <u>left side</u> of the first available page in your DATA COLLECTION section, record information about the CQ book you are reading. You can use one of the following techniques:

- 1. Newspaper Report / Article
- 2. A Bulleted List of Main Points and Important Information
- 3. A mind map / graphic web elaborating to at least three levels of detail

Your recording of data can refer to the whole of what you have read thus far, or it can relate to some salient point or points that you feel are really interesting or important upon which you wish to focus.

On the <u>right side</u> page next to your recording of the data, you are to interact with that information, do something with that information, create something with that information. Some sample ideas might be:

- 1. An editorial to the newspaper about the report / article
- 2. A conversation between two or more people, written in properly punctuated dialogue that discusses the list of bulleted main points
- 3. Create an invention using the information from your mind map.
  - Draw a detailed diagram of the invention if it is a physical "thing" like a machine, or piece of furniture, etc. Make sure to label key parts and functions. OR
  - Write a descriptive summary of the invention if it is something like a new idea, procedure, or social movement, like a new idea for elections, a new way to deal with poverty, a way to get traffic to move more smoothly, etc.

The idea here is to match the item you choose in your left side reporting with the product in the right side transformation (1 with 1, 2 with 2, 3 with 3.) You are to do one item with one item, not all three. If you can find a different way to mix or match, propose it to me. Good luck.
