On the <u>left side</u> of the first available page in your DATA COLLECTION section, record information about the CQ book you are reading. You can use one of the following techniques:

- Summary
- Personal Response
- Outline
- Mind Map (Web)

Your recording of data can refer to the whole of what you have read thus far, or it can relate to some salient point or points that you feel are really interesting or important upon which you wish to focus.

On the <u>right side</u> page next to your recording of the data, you are to interact with that information, do something with that information, create something with that information. Some sample ideas might be:

- A crossword puzzle using key ideas or terms
- A nicely executed illustration of some key idea, event, or person
- An editorial to a newspaper
- A letter to an expert in the field outlining your interest and any questions you might like to ask.
- A poem
- A set of instructions on how to do something related to your reading.
- Create a collage (at home)
- Develop a discography (list of songs and artists) that would express ideas and information concerning your question.

Once again, these are only suggestion to start. You can create your own. You might want to check with me first to see if it fits the idea. Good luck.
