

MULTI-GENRE RESEARCH/RESPONSE PAPER

Your multi-genre paper will combine a variety of genre (poetry, character study, lists, personal accounts, narratives, letters, diary entries, dialogue, memos, pictures, drawings, essays, reports, etc.) to present a historical picture of the Holocaust.

This should be put together like a scrapbook, with a variety of entries that reflect your learning, feelings, and the feelings of those who might have experienced this event.

You should convey accurate information as well as personal response.

The paper must contain a minimum of eight entries, using at least five different genre.

You may use the Internet as a *source*, but not as a genre or entry.

Photographs may be used as part of a collage or to enhance one of your entries.

If you do a chronology, do not simply copy one from a book. Select the events that are significant to you or the aspect of the Holocaust you are studying.

Your paper should contain an index explaining each entry.

Your sources must be listed on a reference sheet.
